In the Saturday morning Nov/Int seminar Barb will work with teams on handling and communicating

with their dogs as well as smoothing out crosses and timing. Often in this level of seminar Barb will mold the handlers time on the floor to address what the team needs most whether it be motivational issues or an issue with a particular obstacle.

The Saturday afternoon and Sunday seminar will focus on more advanced teams. Barb finds that when competing at top levels analysis becomes necessary to help the handler find places to shave off seconds. Barb will work with advanced students to help find ways to improve their times.

Most errors in the agility ring occur because the dog misunderstands what the handler is asking of them. Barb will work with participants to improve the handler's ability to communicate with their dog on the agility field. Handlers will learn the key role that their body language plays in cuing the dog. Also Barb will speak and work with handlers about the many facets involved in correct implementation of the many agility moves and crosses. She will also work with handlers on ways to keep their dogs motivated and running with enthusiasm.
