CLASSES OFFERED

All levels of Regular, JWW, FAST and T2B, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the **American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390**, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class. **You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).** Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated. If you have questions about which class to enter, contact the Trial Secretary **before** the closing date.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form please indicate if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO). The only exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

MOVE UPS

Move-ups as a result of titles earned after entries close must be submitted in writing or email to the Trial Secretary (mimm481@gmail.com) by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, August 31, 2015**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. You may also reply to the emailed confirmation you receive, as it includes all the necessary information. No phone move ups will be accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the last class each day.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that is registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate, provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Please designate the dogs breed as "All-American" on the entry form.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials, available at www.akc.org. The equipment for this event is provided by K-9 Sports. Information on equipment rental can be obtained by contacting Lori at Lori@k-9sports.com or (503) 632-2227. All classes will take place outdoors on grass. Ring size will be 100' x 100'.

Please make checks payable to Columbia Basin Dog Training Club or "CBDTC". No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Mim Myren at mimm481@gmail.com.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, or telephone entries cannot be accepted, and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached cannot be accepted. Checks for entry fees will be deposited soon after the closing date. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry, and the Trial Secretary will add \$30.00 as a returned check fee.

ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

“CBDTC is accepting online entries through the R2 Agility Online (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 100; Paper entries: 230. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.”

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered;
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, or UPS. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) **Express mail must be designated “no signature required.”**

CBDTC is using a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date/time. A maximum of 25 runs will be placed on each trials wait list. All entries must be **received** by the Trial Secretary prior to closing on August 21, 2015 at 5:00pm Pacific Time. Any entries withdrawn, with written notification to the Trial Secretary by 6:00pm on August 28, 2015 will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry; otherwise no refund will be given for withdrawn entries, except as specified within this premium. Any wait listed entry that does not get into the trial will receive a full refund.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Classes will alternate between the two rings; course building and walk thru will take place in one ring while the other ring is running.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

<i>First Place</i>	<i>Blue</i>
<i>Second Place</i>	<i>Red</i>
<i>Third Place</i>	<i>Yellow</i>
<i>Fourth Place</i>	<i>White</i>
<i>Qualifying Score</i>	<i>Dark Green</i>

Each day of the trial, CBDTC will offer “**High in Class**” awards for each Standard and JWW class (Regular & Preferred). The highest qualifying score will be awarded a certificate for \$10.00 in entry fees to the 2016 CBDTC AKC Agility Trial. (All jump heights within the class calculated together, with ties broken by yards per second.) A small gift (under \$3.00 in value) will be available at check in for each exhibitor. (One gift per exhibitor for the weekend please.) Title ribbons will be available for those achieving a title at these trials. A whiner’s raffle for a bottle of local wine will be conducted each day.

A MACH, PACH or PAX rosette and decorated bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH, PACH, or PAX. Please advise the trial secretary so we can be prepared to celebrate appropriately.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Columbia Basin Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Columbia Basin Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Columbia Basin Dog Training Club or any official thereof. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. A full refund of entry fees will be given for any reason if a written (or email) notification is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing of the trial.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund the full amount if the trial secretary has confirmed receipt of information on or before the close of the trial. After closing, refunds less \$6.00 in fees/day will be given for bitches in season, if written or email notification is received by the TRIAL SECRETARY prior to the start of the trial. Verification from a veterinarian may be required at the club's discretion.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system, stewards, or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

VOLUNTEERS WILL RECEIVE LUNCH ON US!! In order to make this a successful Trial, we will need your time and expertise to help with various tasks. We will have a white board for worker sign-ups at the trial each day. We appreciate our volunteers and lunch will be provided each day at the trial for volunteers. You need not have experience.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

The rings will be fenced with temporary fencing and have entry and exit openings. Crating space will be available around the rings; however, there is limited shade, so please plan accordingly. There is no inside crating space available. On Thursday the grounds will be available for set up beginning at 6:00pm- or AFTER the rings have been set. Please DO NOT set your crating, e-z ups, mats etc. prior to the equipment being moved in and the rings set up. We would appreciate any help with setting up and volunteers will have the first opportunity to set up.

No food concessions are available on the site. Please be aware that the closest town is at least 10 minutes from the show site. **A catered lunch will be provided for trial volunteers, or by donation by Beverly Jones from the Wenatchee Trial. Breakfast will be also be available all 3 days for donation.**

As has been our tradition for several years, CBDC will be hosting evening events with our Judges at the trial site each evening and everyone is welcome & encouraged to attend. Friday we will provide pulled pork sandwiches, Saturday-the traditional "Cream Can" Supper, and Sunday we ask that you join us and bring your favorite appetizer & beverage to share. Each evening the club will provide the main dish and ask that you sign up with how many people will be joining us so that we can plan according. - Interstate 90 East to I-82 toward RICHLAND/PASCO
- Merge onto I-82E Exit 110 toward YAKIMA
- Take the WA-225 N Exit, Exit 96, toward WEST RICHLAND/BENTON CITY
- Turn LEFT onto WA-225, at stop sign go STRAIGHT on WA-225, crossing the river.
- Turn right into park, if you get to WA-240, you've gone too far.

Article I. AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only.
