Diane Bauman is the author of "Beyond Basic Dog Training" now in its third edition, having withstood the test of time and over 30 years. She also is the author of "Agility Start To Finish". She is one of today's most successful professionals in the field of canine agility and obedience. Diane uses her talents and innate sensitivity for understanding how dogs think and how people learn. She is internationally known for her obedience instruction. Diane's novel, proven method "teaches" rather than "trains" dogs. As Diane explains, "the approach cultivates a thinking dog that can problem solve both in and out of the competition ring." Very few trainers have been as successful training so many different breeds of dogs and rescued dogs to high levels of accomplishments.

Among her list of accomplishments are:

- 16 perfect 200 scores in obedience (on a Golden, Belgian Tervuren, Keeshond and Pomeranian)
- Trained 1st AM, Can, OTCH, TD Keeshond in the history of the breed
- Trained OTCH Pomeranian (rescued from a shelter at age 6)
- Trained 1st OTCH, UDX Pekingese in history of the breed (rescued from shelter at age 10 mos.)
- Placed 4th in Open and 2nd in Utility with a Pekingese at the Gaines/Cycle Eastern Regionals
- Won the Canadian Centennial Obedience competition with a Keeshond
- 1st Master Agility Excellent (Standard & Jumpers) Afghan in the history of the breed
- 3rd MACH of any breed in AKC history with a Cocker Spaniel
- AKC World Agility Team Member in 1998-2000 winning gold and silver medals with a Black American Cocker Spaniel
- 6th at 2009 AKC Eukanuba Agility Invitational with Afghan (Top Afghan for 2011)
- 1st herding title on an Icelandic Sheepdog in US and Canada (also has 2nd herding title)
- Five Tracking Titles (Golden, Keeshond, Papillion, Cocker Spaniel, Icelandic Sheepdog) with the Icelandic being the 1st in the history of the breed
