

Nose Work Workshop with NACSW Instructor Sarah Stevens

May 17th 3-5pm
Columbia Basin Dog Training Club

Nose Work is a sport modeled after professional detection work that will develop your dog's natural scenting ability through their love of food or toys. It is uniquely suited for all dogs to be able to learn, including those who are anxious or excitable. To participate in this workshop dogs do not need to have any prior experience with nose work.

Sarah is a Certified Nose Work Instructor through the National Association of Canine Scent Work from Livermore, CA. She fell in love with the sport since trying it with her older dog, who has several behavioral issues. After seeing how much confidence he gained and how absolutely FUN it was for him, Sarah knew she wanted to help spread this fantastic sport by teaching other dogs and people how to do it too. Working under the guidance of Wendy Krehbiel from Tell a Tail Dog Training in Livermore, CA Sarah started assisting and teaching classes in 2009. In the past she has also trained and socialized rescue dogs with various organizations, including Furry Friends Rescue and The Humane Society of Silicon Valley. Sarah began judging Odor Recognition Trials in 2013.

Sarah will demonstrate advanced nose work with her cattle dog, River, followed by a short lecture. Dogs of all levels are welcome to participate. Each dog will be evaluated individually and given tasks appropriate to their level. All dogs will be crated outside of the workspace when it is not their turn – weather depending either in cars or a shaded space will be provided. Dogs should be on a flat buckle collar and/or harness.
